Leaving Fremantle on March 6, 2011 we will travel North to the remote town of Exmouth in WA's North West. The trip will take 8 nights and will include the Ningaloo Reef, Abrohlos Islands, remote waters of Shark Bay and the rugged Cape Range National Park.

Along the way while taking in the sights, you will be trained by Oscar and Dean and learn the secrets of downwind mastery.

Everyday you will wake up in a new location with a new challenge set by Oscar and Dean. While you are not being challenged by the perfect downwind conditions you will get your chance to fish, dive, surf or just explore this unique coastline.

There will be two sessions a day for each participant with carefully planned technique sessions on board K2O using state of the art paddling ergometers.



Your experience of this wild and adventurous region will be courtesy of K2O. She is a luxury catamaran (only launched in 2004) custom built for luxury cruising. At 22m she is almost half the size of an Olympic swimming pool, and yet she has such a shallow draft we can take her right in close to the Kimberley coast. She has 3 tenders that we use to take you to the creeks, beaches, rivers and waterfalls.


Dean Gardiner
